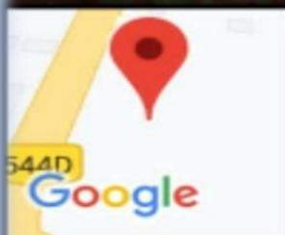

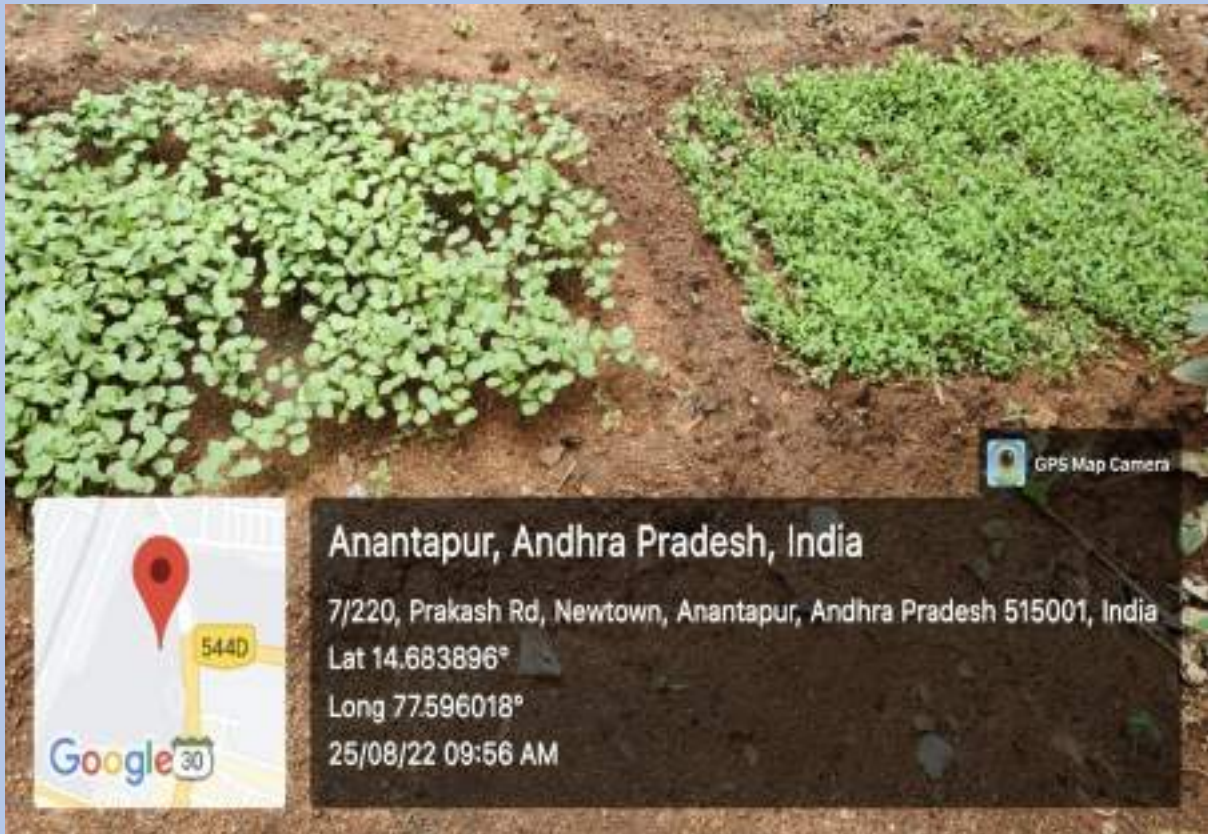

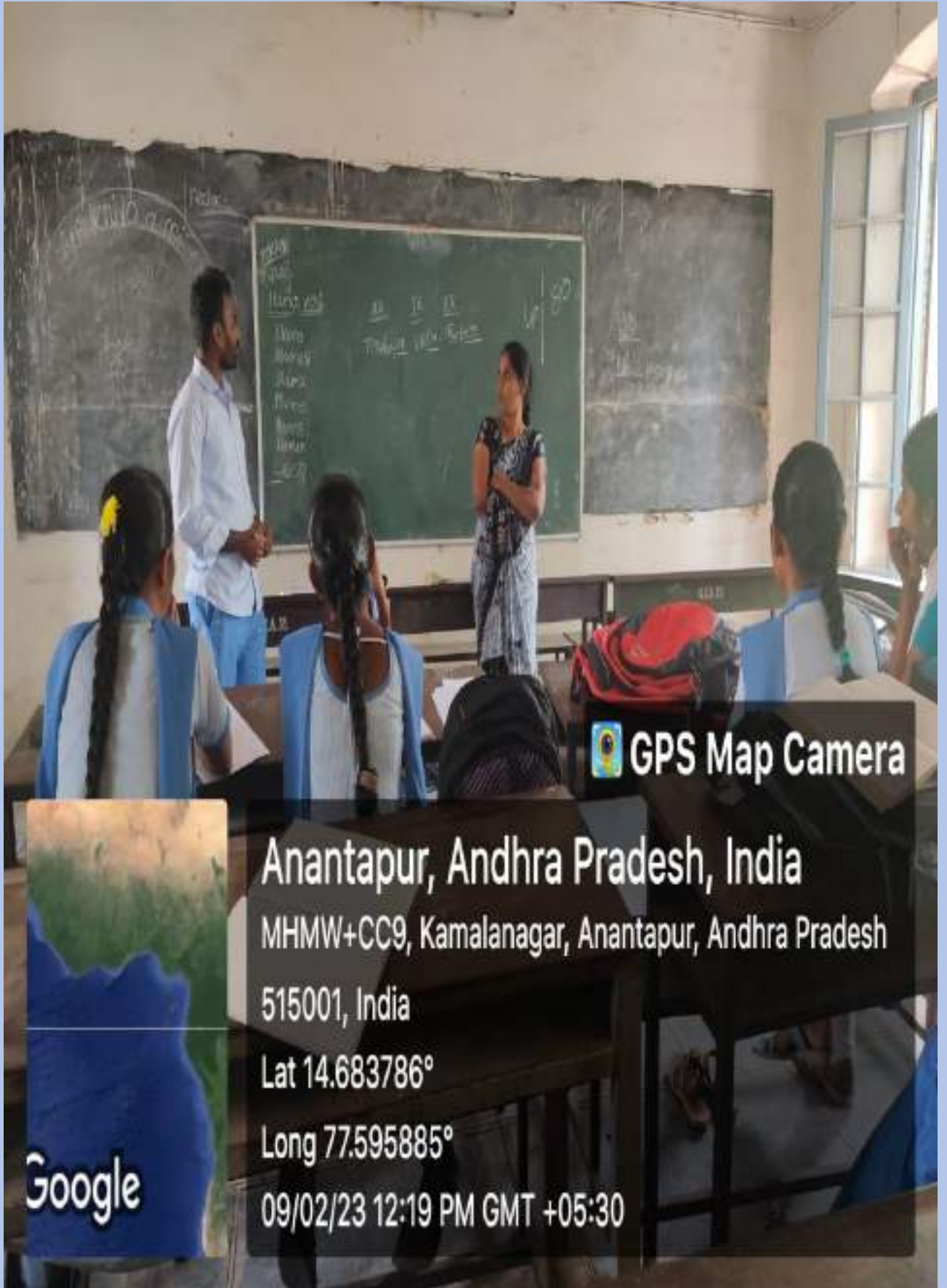

School Montcau-La Mola from Matadepera (Spain) has been actively collaborating with Vicente Ferrer's Foundation (RDT) since 2018.

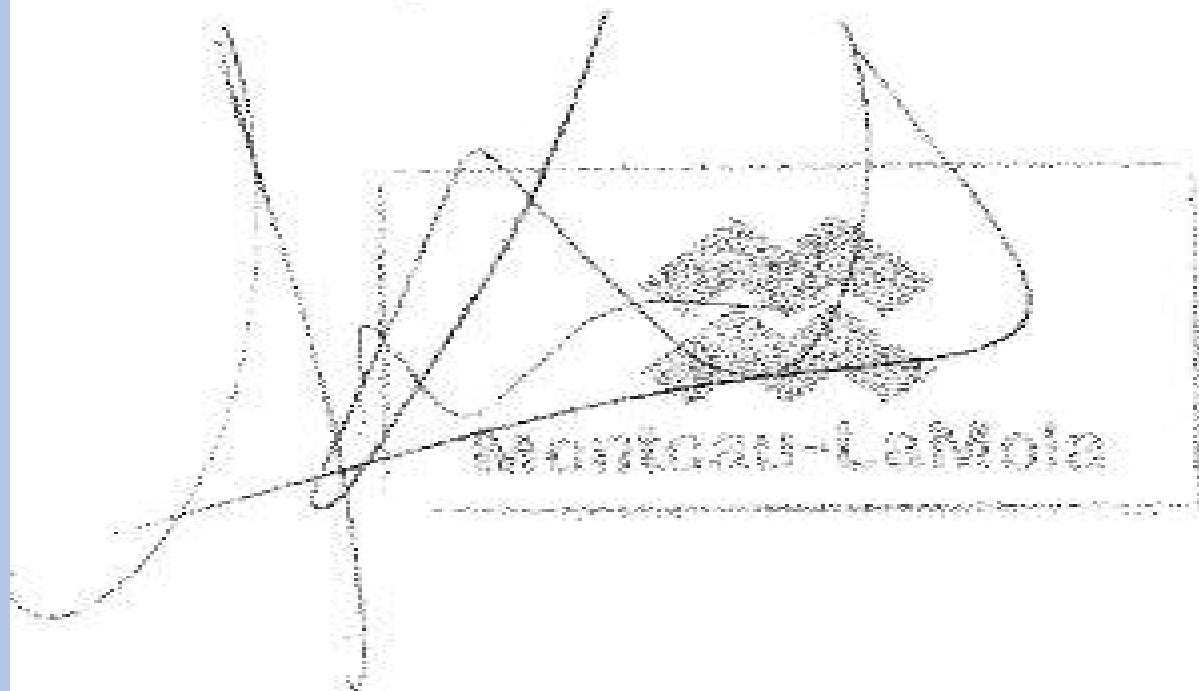
