Collection of Feedback

1. Student feedback Analysis:

Questionnaire for students is structured with Twelve questions on curriculum, Academic Environment. The questions in all these cases are to be answered on 5 rating scale beginning poor to excellent and one open question for suggestions.

Major suggestions from stakeholders were forwarded to concerned Departments for Action.

During the academic year 2017-18, 656 students from 37 UG programmes and 15 PG programmes gave their feedback on curriculum and academic environment and other student related services on campus.

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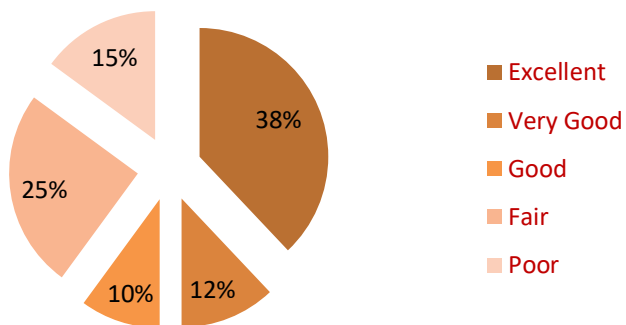


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Coverage of syllabus

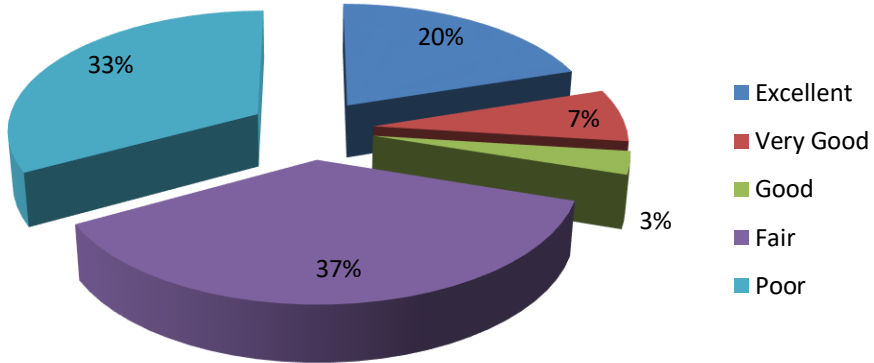


Scope for Skill development in the Curriculum

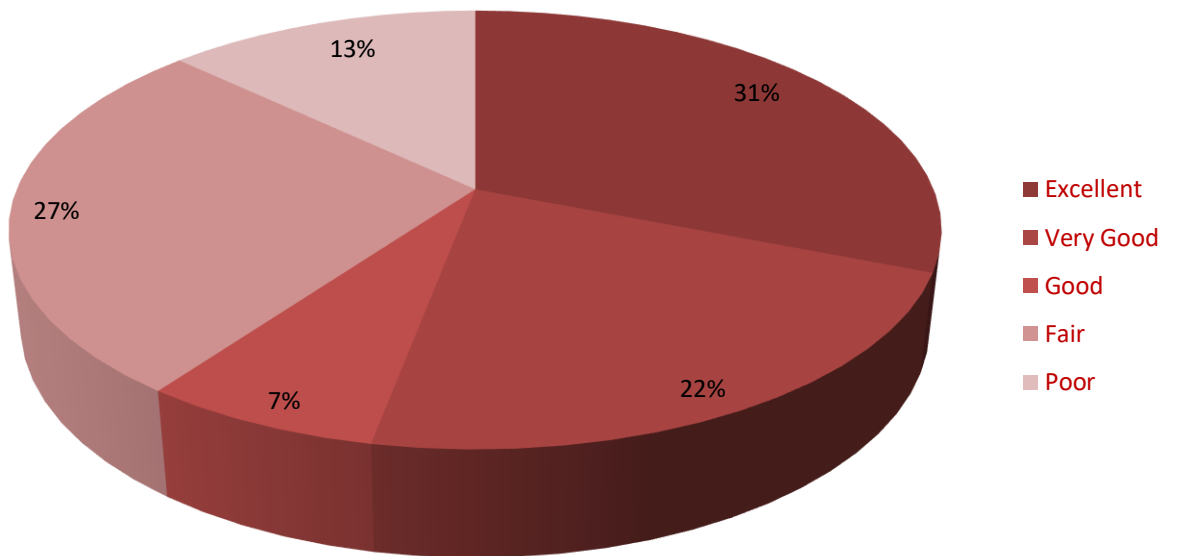

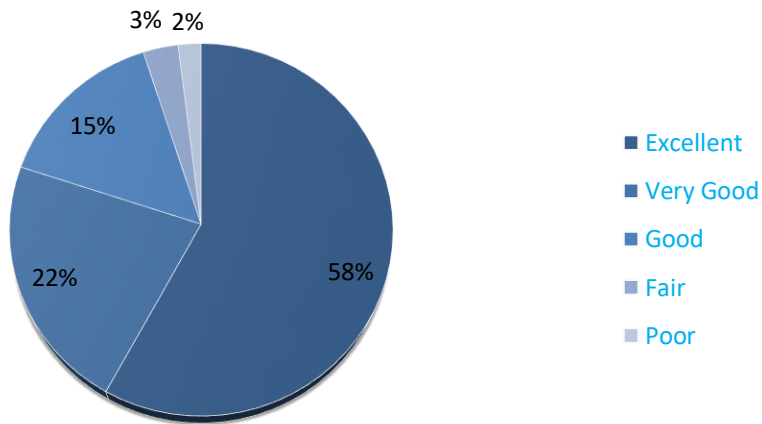

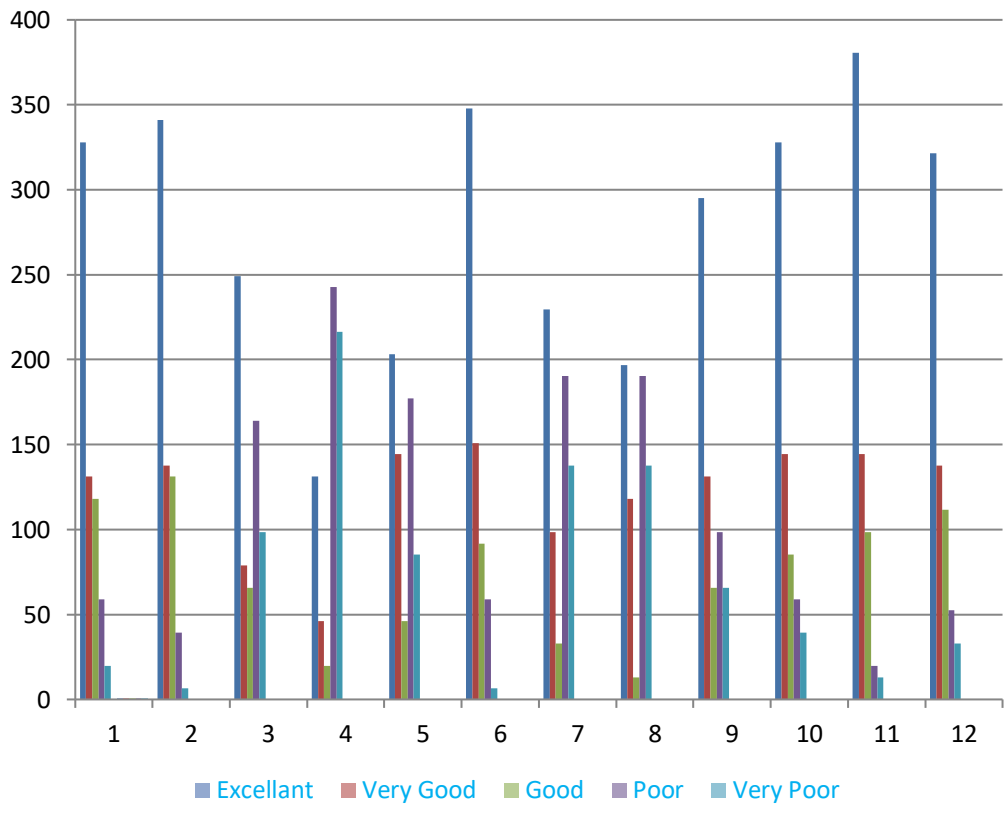

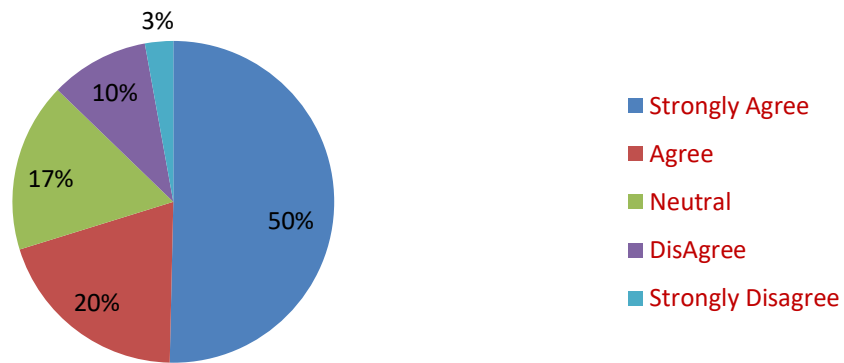

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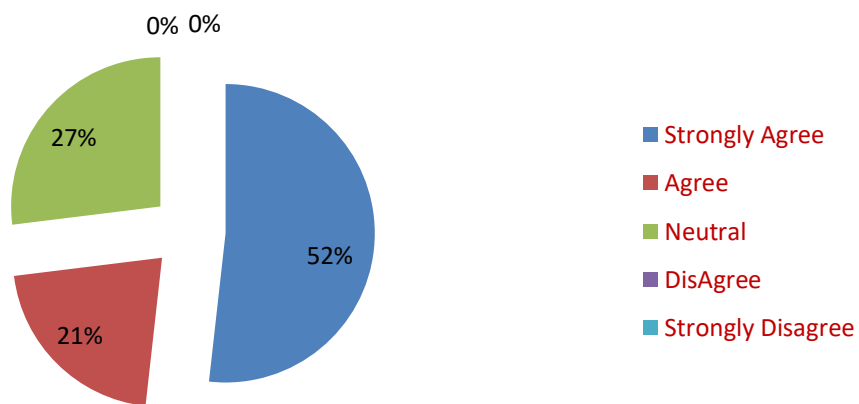

Curriculum Design & Course Syllabi

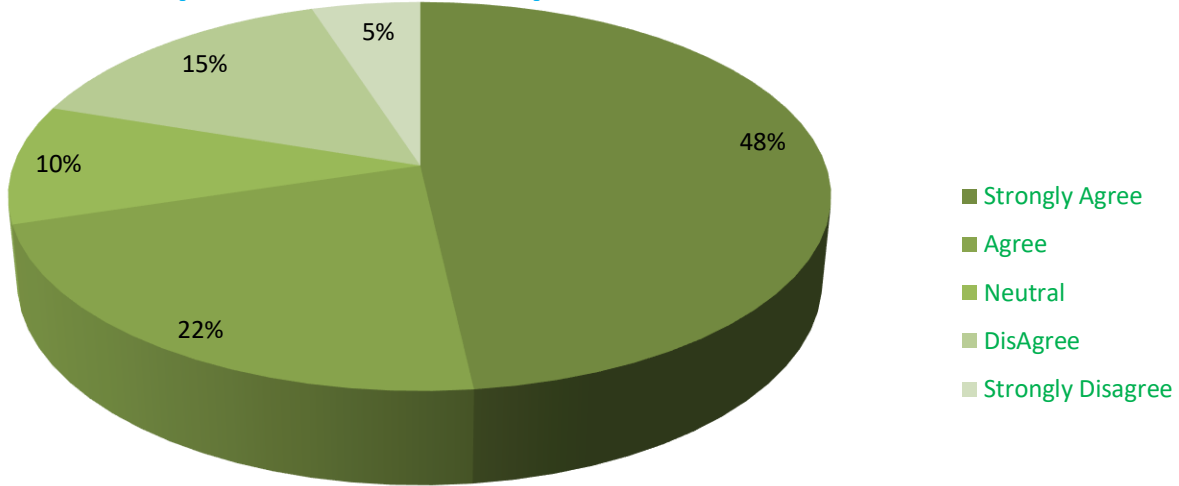


Coverage of syllabus

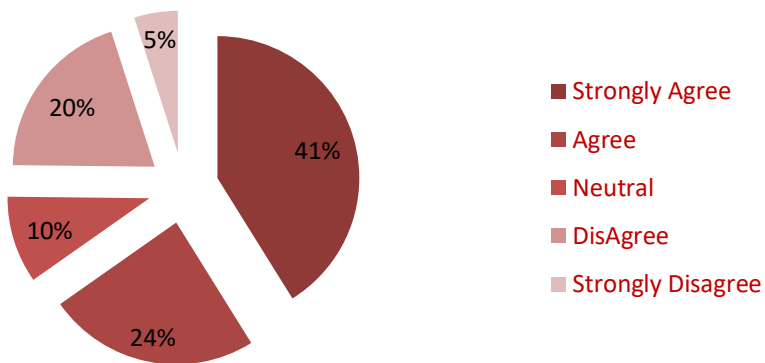

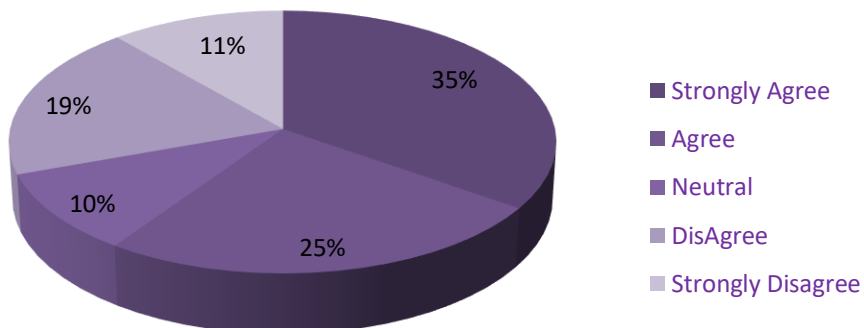
Scope for Skill development in the Curriculum

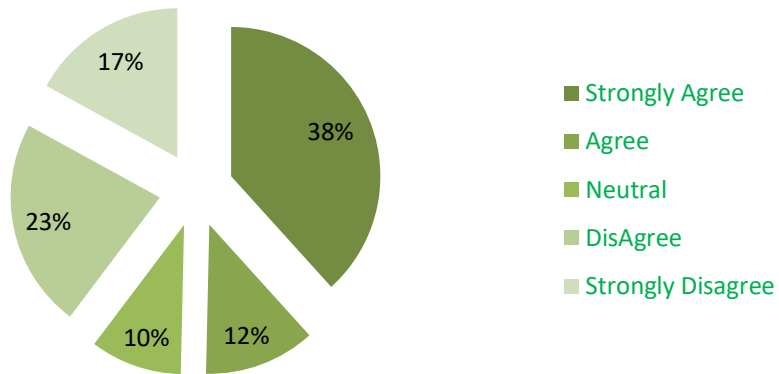


Usage of ICT

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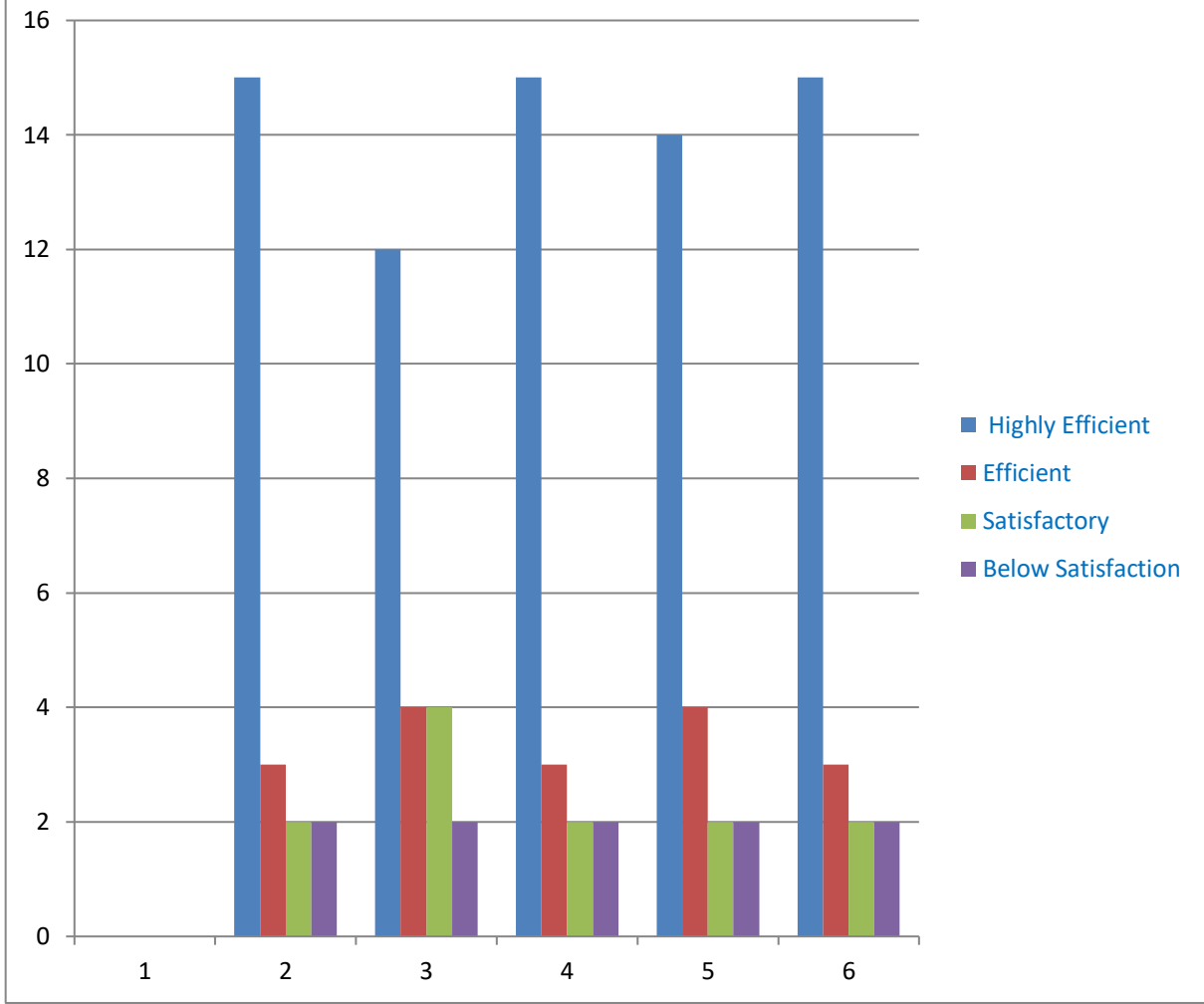

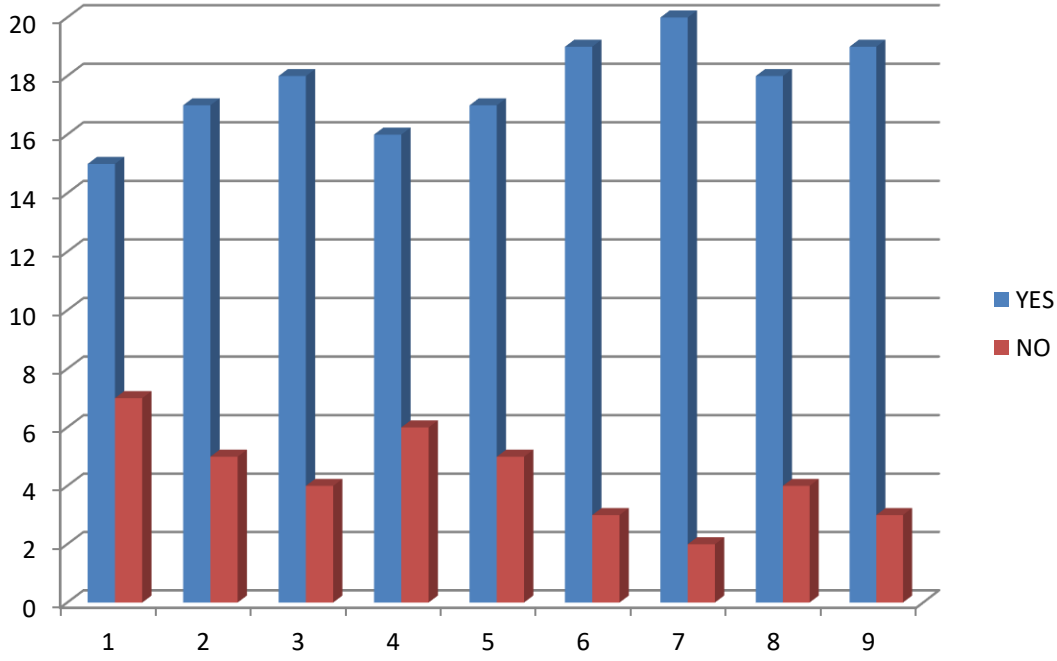
